TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS

1. A player shall not participate in more than one tournament using a Traditional Draw during the same period, except when two events overlap by not more than two days, and then only with the prior written permission of the organisers of each event. Any player submitting entries to more than one event overlapping by more than two days shall withdraw from all but one before the closing date for entries in each event. Events using a Progressive Draw may constitute an exception to this regulation, with prior permission as above. See also Appendix B 1.1.2 regarding players in representative events. Please note **LTA Tournament Regulation Rule 2.5.8** regarding reserve lists/withdrawals.
2. The Tournament will be run in strict accordance with **ITF Rules of Tennis**, **LTA Rules of Tennis** and **LTA Tournament Regulations** including **The LTA Code of Conduct Rules** (as each may be amended from time to time).
3. **Footwear & Clothing:** Competitors are required to wear suitable footwear and acceptable tennis attire. (**Rule 3**)
4. **Disciplinary Statement:** All players are subject to **LTA Rules & Regulations** (including **LTA Tournament Regulations**, **Anti-Doping Programme**, **Disciplinary & Dispute Resolution Procedures**, **Match Fixing Regulations**, **Financial Speculation & Betting**) and must fully and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction and authority of LTA and the Scottish Legal System.
5. **Media Statement:** From time to time there may be media interest in the Tournament involving photographs, interviews and TV footage. Any player wishing to opt out of any such activity should inform the Tournament Organiser.
6. **British Tennis Membership:** Details on this entry form may be used to update the BTM records of the person identified.
7. **Data Usage Statement:** LTA, TENNIS SCOTLAND & local Tournament organisers may wish to communicate information about this and other tournaments to players using contact details from this form.
8. **The Prize Money** may be reduced in any event where the entries are lower than 16.
9. **Competitors Entries are Restricted as Follows:**
Availability for open events is at the discretion of the Referee. Tableau finale and staggered draw format may be adopted
9am: 5 events maximum (3 singles events max.)
2pm: 4 events maximum (2 open events max)
6pm: 2 handicap events max. (no open events)
No Player may enter more than **ONE handicap DOUBLES** event. The Committee reserve the right to further restrict entries if necessary
Competitors in **JUNIOR** events **MUST ALWAYS** be available from **9am** daily.

It is assumed that ALL players (except in 10&U and 8&U) will be available from 9AM ON SUNDAY 31 JULY 2011

PLEASE NOTE: 10&U and 8&U Round Robin Events will be played on Saturday 6 August at Cults LTC from 9.30am
